

Guidance for End of Life Care Discharge

Consultant and MDT agreement between all health/social care professionals. This may include Specialist Palliative care team members.



Review care needs at home, this includes funding care so need to complete:

• Nursing Needs Assessment for Fast track care at end of life (this is irrespective of section 117 which can be overridden at this time).



Occupational Therapy or Physiotherapy Review of Equipment required:

• Equipment needs at home should be assessed by OT/Physio this may involve a home visit assessment (*including hospital bed, pressure mattress, hoist etc*).



You may be required to obtain an authorisation code to access end of life care community equipment. The OT/Physio in each area should have access to this. If you don't have this code Contact:
